Guidelines for Authors (Contributors)

- (i) English is the only language accepted in the journal.
- (ii) The paper published earlier in any journal cannot be accepted.
- (iii) Submit the paper with a plagiarised report of **DrillBit detection software**, which must be below 10%. The author shall be held responsible for breaching UGC norms and violating the publication ethics.
- (iv) **Times New Roman font** size 12 and 1.5 spacing is required.
- (v) Use **APA** 6th **format** when referencing (footnotes only)
- (vi) Submissions of the papers are between 3500 and 5000 words, including notes and references.
- (vii) The paper contains an Abstract of 300 words, along with five to seven keywords.

- (viii) After review, if required, any modifications will be reported to the authors, who will have a maximum of seven days to make the necessary corrections.
- (ix) Following acceptance, a soft copy of the paper *may be* mailed to the authors for proofreading. Within five days, the same has to be completed. At this point, only a few adjustments will be considered. The author should keep the matter secret till the publication of the journal.
- (x) The deadline for the submissions of papers will be from 1st June to 30th November 2024.
- (xi) The title page should bear the following information apart from the title:
- (i) Author's name
- (ii) The affiliations of the author
- (iii) An active email address of the author
- (xii) The author should submit one copy of the PDF and one copy of the Word file for the complete paper.
